Preparation Cont.

Stock up on emergency material:

Ensure that emergency kits contain basic material to cope with all identified hazards.


In the case of Covid-19 ensure you have the following:

- Access to water
- Masks
- Hansanitizers
- Soap
- Masks
- Latex or latex free gloves
- Disposable Hazmat suits for designated people.
- Touch free thermometers (back up batteries)
- Specific or dedicated isolation areas

Develop and information-sharing strategy (this can be digital, audio or paper based).

Develop a communication plan and ensure that all required contact details are available.

Setup school apps or whatsapp groups to communicate information.



Prevention

- Create awareness through information sharing.
- Wash your hands regularly for at least 20 second with soap and water
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands
- Promote self-home assessments
- Avoid large gatherings and and promote small group interactions at least until the threat/hazard has been cleared.
- Avoid close contact with those who are sick and stay home if you are sick.
- Promote daily deep cleaning of ablution facilities
- Promote cleaning of learner working surfaces.
- Ensure, if possible, that there is handsanitizer in ablution facilties and in each classroom.

- If there are financial constraints, ensure that there is sufficient soap and water in ablution facilities. Wash bottles and soap can be placed in strategic areas on the playground.
- Promote covering coughs or sneezes with a flexed elbow or a tissue, then throw the tissue in the bin.

Monitoring and evaluation

- Monitor and plan for absenteeism
- Review Departments of Health and Education announcements continually.
- Create opportunity to discuss and evaluate observations on a daily basis.













Control

- Control in this document is related to the identification of someone with Covid-19 symptoms or who freely discloses travel or illness.
- Establish a procedure for students and staff to follow in the event of someone becoming ill.
- Follow your general incident reporting procedures (ensure parents are notified).
- Ensure the learner or staff member is isolated and has a mask.
- Notify the necessary contacts at Departments of Health and Education.
- If possible determine who the person has been in contact with and temporarily isolate the group until further instructions from the Departments of Health and Education.
- Avoid panic and reassure everyone that the required steps have been taken.
- Ensure that you follow the neccessary preventitive measures e.g deep cleansing.
- Ensure that cleaning staff have the necessary personal protective clothing.
- Ensure that all Departments of Education and Health's policies are followed.
- Be prepared to dismiss school and cancel events if so instructed.
